Eligibility:  Initiative promotes medical student leadership, professionalism, inter-professional & community collaboration, health advocacy, wellness and building professional core competencies or clinical skills Initiative is open to all medical students  Examples of previously funded projects: AMSCAR Inclusive Health: An LGBTQ+ Healthcare Primer Indigenous Health Speaker Series Political Action Committee Political Advocacy Day Training Mental Health Week	Eligibility:  Open to medical students and resident physicians Projects must enhance and/or promote the wellbeing of Albertans through: Health-related education Advocacy, and/or Community-service projects  Examples of previously funded projects: Early intervention strategies for children exposed to domestic violence Education about drug and opioid use Promoting physical activity for children with disabilities Sun and Skin Safety Awareness Teaching CPR at sporting events
